Assalamu Walkum,

Considering the present immigration policy of the Bangladesh Government, brothers who intend to participate in the upcoming Tongi Ijtima (13,14,15 & 20,21,22 Jan. 2017) are requested to strictly abide by the following instructions-

- (1) If Bangladesh Embassy / Foreign Missions are available in the residence country, brothers must collect TI VISA, before coming to Dhaka. They will not get visa on arrival, violation of this regulation may cause deportation from Dhaka Airport.
- (2) 'VISA ON ARRIVAL' will be issued to citizens of those countries where Bangladesh Embassy / Foreign Missions are not present, subject to the following conditions-
 - a) Brothers must have sponsor letter from Kakrail Masjid &
 - b) Recommendation letter from respective Country Markaz/responsible brothers
- (3) All the brothers intending to join Tongi Ijtima from 13,14,15 & 20,21,22 Jan. 2017, are requested to send passport particulars as follows, not later than 10th December 2016, for prior security clearance. Please send to the following mails forooque@cc.buet.ac.bd or arkakrail@gmail.com.



Subject: Visa instructions for Bangladesh Missions abroad regarding issuance of visa to foreign nationals intending to join Bishwa Ijtema in Dhaka from 13-15 January, 2017 and 20-22 January, 2017.

The undersigned is directed to convey that the following instructions for issuance of visa for foreign nationals intending to join Bishwa Ijtema, 2017 are to be followed:

1. **Visa Category : "TI"**
2. **Duration of Visa :**
 - (i) Generally for 30 (thirty) days, maximum 50 days for the purpose of Bishwa Ijtema and one Chilla.
 - (ii) Visa may be granted for up to 130 (one hundred thirty) days for three Chillas upon satisfaction of the visa officer.
3. **Conditions :**
 - a) Concerned country's Tabligh Jamaat Markaz/Jimmadars shall give certificate to the effect that the applicant(s), is/are genuine member(s) of the Tablig Jamaat and his/her/their antecedents are in order.
 - b) Citizens of countries that enjoy visa on Arrival (VoA) privilege entering Bangladesh will be required to obtain invitation/recommendation/certificate form the Tableague Markaz of their respective countries in advance before proceeding to Bangladesh for joining in the upcoming Bishwa Ijtema in Bangladesh.
 - c) VoA Privileged countries where Local Tableague Markaz is not available, citizens of those countries will be required to obtain invitation/recommendation/certificate form the central Tableague Markaz Located in Dhaka, Bangladesh in advance before proceeding to Bangladesh for joining in the upcoming Bishwa Ijtema in Bangladesh.
 - d) Bangladesh Missions will **carefully** examine the merit of applications including recommendation/certificate form the central Tableague Markaz Located in Dhaka, Bangladesh as well as certificate given by respective Tabligh Jamaat Markaz/Jimmadar and grant visa for specific duration as mentioned above upon their satisfaction.
 - e) To avoid any possible untoward situation, visa may be granted after proper examination/scrutiny of the relevant documents submitted by the applicants of the countries like Syria, Yemen, Nigeria, Iraq, Somalia, Lebanon, Afghanistan, Sudan, Libya, Pakistan, Chad, Mali, Tunisia, Palestine and Israel.
4. **Conditions for approval of third country visa :**
 - a) Visa may be issued to the participants who will be arriving after performing Holy Hajj in KSA, or who are immigrants or permanent residents in a third country.
 - b) Persons of a third country already participating in Tablig Jamaat, Ijtema/Chillas in UAE, India, Pakistan, Kenya, Malaysia, KSA, Egypt & Jordan and/ or intending to participate in the Bishwa Ijtema in Dhaka may apply for visa to Bangladesh missions in Dubai, Abu Dhabi, New Delhi, Karachi, Nairobi, Kuala Lumpur, Riyadh, Jeddah, Cairo and Amman respectively. The said missions shall follow all the procedures stated above before granting visa to such applicants.
 - c) Palestinian and Israeli Muslim citizens holding Israeli passports, however, may be granted visa in a separate paper under the above mentioned conditions of 2, 3(a), 3(b), 3(c) & 3(d) by Bangladesh Missions in their neighbouring countries.
